the Flea is an extremely successful intruder which has survived thousands of years through an ability to adapt to and infest its environment surviving based on a readily available food source which is provided by both human and animal hosts. Treatment for Flea intruders is laborious and can bear very limited results should the client fail to prepare appropriately for treatment. Due to its size, and tough exterior anatomy it is very difficult to eliminate without professional control products and could spread rapidly if treatment and post treatment recommendations are not undertaken with careful determination and a continually aggressive approach with focus on elimination of breeding cycles. Understanding this, following the procedures below and working in conjunction with your Pest Control Technician. Control measures can be extremely effective. However, it is imperative that the client understand their role in controlling the pest. Controlling and eliminating a problem is a Team Effort.

- 1. Clear ALL floor areas of ALL personal belongings (furniture excluded)
- 2. Remove all obstructions from walls and place in middle of ALL rooms.
- 3. Complete thorough vacuum of ALL rooms with focus on baseboard areas.
- 4. Run all bedding, clothing, linens and fabrics through FULL dry cycle on high heat. (Laundering not required)
